The Cincinnati Police Department objects to the issuance of the above liquor license. The Cincinnati Police Department believes that the granting of this application will breach the peace, sobriety, and the good order of the neighborhood. The current operation of the store shows a pattern of disregard for the laws, regulations, or local ordinances of this state. In the past year, the establishment has been cited twice for underage alcohol sales. There is currently an ongoing investigation by the Cincinnati Police Department into the premises operation. Based on this information the Cincinnati Police Department wishes to object.

The Department of Buildings & Inspections, Health Department, Cincinnati Recreation Commission, and Park Board have completed their investigations regarding this application and do not object.

On May 25, 2011 East Price Hill Improvement Association was notified of this application and do not object.
