

We MOVE that the Administration revise Sec. 508.12 to require 24 hours of notice for residents to move parked cars in non-metered areas for any and all such events where the City or a designated 3rd Party may post temporary no parking restrictions (ie. Street sweeping, utility replacement, street resurfacing, parades, races, etc.). 14 hours of notice will remain for locations with parking meters.

STATEMENT

The purpose of this motion is to address the seemingly arbitrary designation of 14 hours and to provide ample time to residents in densely populated neighborhoods who may not use their vehicles multiple times a day. Knowing that one must check on/move their vehicle once every 24 hours will provide clarity and understanding for residents. Additionally, major urban cities, such as Seattle, Washington and San Francisco, CA, require 24 hours of public notice prior to placing temporary No Parking restrictions on City streets.
