





Statement

Currently, the City uses the United States Postal Service (“snail mail”) to send the City Bulletin, notification of public hearings, and other information to community councils. This method is costly and not as timely as electronic communication methods. The City currently has a list of Community Council email addresses, which will offer opportunities to reach a large number of community leaders in a more timely and cost-efficient manner.
