MOTION

WHEREAS, traffic movements have changed significantly since the last traffic signal study was completed in downtown Cincinnati in the mid-1990s in regards volume, modes, destinations, and of location of parking; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that a downtown traffic signal timing and traffic study will result in recommendations to the Administration for updating traffic signal timing in downtown Cincinnati; now therefore,

WE MOVE that the Administration take all necessary steps to ensure that the signal retiming study results in recommendations that optimize and maximize the efficient movement of all users of the public right-of-way consistent with best practices for traffic engineering, including, at minimum, users of automobiles, buses, the Cincinnati Bell Connector, and pedestrians.
