

RESOLUTION NO. 50 - 2016

RECOGNIZING Angelita Moreno Jones for her achievements as founder, President, and Chief Executive Officer of Eastern Personnel Services, Inc., a nationally recognized employment staffing service, and for her commitment to improving the skill sets and positively impacting the lives of those seeking employment in the Cincinnati community.

WHEREAS, after working for ten years in the private sector and overcoming personal and financial obstacles, Angelita Moreno Jones started Eastern Personnel Services in 1987 and grew the company into a nationally known, full service staffing agency for temporary, contract, and professional employees in the business, manufacturing, and medical fields; and

WHEREAS, Angelita Moreno Jones started her company in response to a shrinking quality workforce in the region and also worked to help local job seekers by producing training videos to enhance workers' skills and authoring books to guide small business owners; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of her role as a leader in her field, a spokesperson for African-American women, and an effective advocate for entrepreneurs, Angelita Moreno Jones has received many awards including Woman Entrepreneur of the Year, YWCA Career Woman of Achievement, and the Leading Women's Award; and

WHEREAS, Angelita Moreno Jones has served on the board of trustees for the Union Foundation and the Collective Empowerment Group, as a member of Women Entrepreneurs, Inc., as co-chair and committee member of the Black Agenda Cincinnati African American Summit, and as Board Chair of the African American Chamber of Commerce, and she annually serves her community through the 33rd District Job Fair; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:
